This program is designed to provide highly motivated students from colleges and universities with mentors from our industry. From June of 2007 to May of 2008, Sheilah Belle, News and Community Affairs Director mentored 15 students from Virginia Commonwealth University who is majoring in Communications. Also in 2007, Kat Simons, WTVR Midday Air Personality mentored seven students from Lee Davis High School, VCU, WVU, and, Hampton University.</p>

From June of 2007-2008 there have been 25 internships from Virginia State University, Virginia Commonwealth University, Virginia Union University, and George Mason University that have or are currently participating in this program.</p>
